The Career day “Career4all – Heraklion Crete” includes the following:

Interviews with company representatives:

- The interviews will be conducted in Greek or/and English, but for your convenience there will be interpretation in Farsi, Arabic and Ukrainian.
- It is recommended to have printed copies of your CV with you in order to give it them to the company representatives who will interview you.

Conference:

- The conference includes sessions by company representatives and other actors. The goal is to provide information regarding the labour market in Crete, the work opportunities and the necessary preparation needed to secure an employment opportunity. During the conference, simultaneous interpretation will be provided in English, Arabic, French and Farsi.
- The conference agenda will be disseminated when finalized.
- In order to receive the necessary equipment for the interpretation, you will be required to give your identification document (Asylum Seeker’s Card, Residence Permit (ADET), passport or Identity card) in exchange for the equipment. On returning the equipment, you will receive your documents back.

** For educational reasons the conference will be recorded and a press release including photos of the event will be shared. The conference will be broadcasted live.*

It is reminded that the attendees must wear a mask when they arrive and throughout the event and strictly follow the health protocols.
